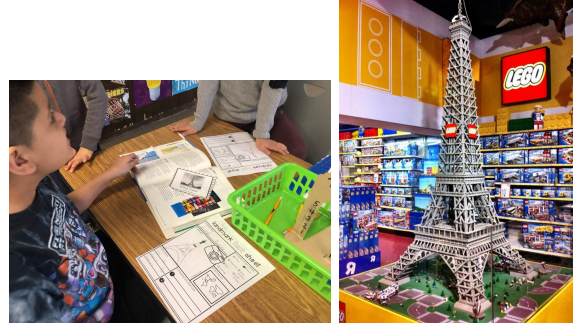
Landmarks & Google Earth
