Foundations of Technology (STEM 1) prepares students to understand and apply the concepts and processes that are the cornerstone of the high school technology program. Throughout this course, group and individual activities engage students in developing ideas and applying science, mathematics, and other school subjects as they engineer practical solutions to real-life problems. As students build STEM skills and enhance their technological literacy, they will gain a better understanding of how the world works and ultimately become more innovative contributors to society.

STEM 1 is a demanding hands-on course which requires reading and studying to learn the language and concepts.
