 - A. Guidelines to Speak to the Board of Education There were no citizens wishing to be heard.

Pamela Hallman-Johnson thanked community members who shared their concerns. What can we do to move the work forward when it comes to those concerns? How staff responds to threats to Juan v Johnny (depending on the color of their skin). There are many programs for restorative justice practices to support when infractions are committed. Safety is a major priority. There is no right or wrong answer when it comes to complex situations. Lives are at stake. Whatever we can do we must do collectively, as a community and as a Board. Michael commended Dr. Mauricio on how he has been handling threats in the district.
