Dear Peekskill Families,

I am writing with a few brief updates this week, but I would be remiss if I did not once again pause to reflect on the current events taking place across our nation. Along with adults, our children are making sense of the news presented to them and I urge you to use these instances as teachable moments to promote empathy, equity and peace. As a reminder, our clinical and counseling team is available to support students and families during this challenging time. Re-Entry Planning Committees

Our District has begun planning for the return to school in September and has formed several re-entry committees. These committees are made up of PCSD administrators, staff and parents. At this time, we do not know what the guidance from New York State will be, but we are planning for three possible scenarios:

- 1. A full return of all students to in-person classes
- 2. A full virtual learning environment
- 3. A hybrid model that consists of 50% of students attending each day.

We will continue to provide information about our committees' work as we move forward. This information will be presented publicly at a future date.

Elementary Student Instrument Drop Off & Pick Up of Personal Belongings

Parents should complete this <u>Summer Instrument Loan Contract</u> if their students have already received permission from their music teacher to keep instruments over the summer months. A drive through instrument drop-off/personal belonging pick-up will be available on June 15 - June 19 from 9AM-12PM at all elementary schools.

Secondary buildings will continue with their instrument drop-off/personal belonging pick-up as scheduled. If you have not arranged a time to return and pick-up items, please reach out to your building's principal.

Chromebooks
