On May 1, Governor Cuomo announced that all New York State Schools will **remain closed for the remainder of the 2019-2020 academic year**. While we prepared for the possibility of this news over the past few weeks, we understand that there will be mixed emotions surrounding this decision.

While this decision is challenging to us all, we understand that it is based on the health and welfare of our communities. To the families affected by this decision, and especially our graduating Class of 2020, know that we share in the feelings of disappointment that have become our reality due to COVID-19. Please know that our District administration will continue to work on ways to honor our students' hard work and accomplishments in the coming weeks. This includes celebrating our senior class in relation to college and post-secondary Decision Day, graduation and other important milestones. We have begun to highlight our seniors' decisions virtually and invite you to visit our social media accounts to share in these students' exciting announcements. We will update our school community with additional details as plans for future events are finalized.

August Regents Exams

The Board of Regents and NYS Education Department has now cancelled August Regents Exams in addition to the previously cancelled June Exams. Please be reminded that to qualify for the exemption, students must earn credit in the course of study by the end of the 2019-2020 school year. Students will only receive Regents Exam credit if they have met the standards for passing the course. It is important for students to complete their school work and participate in classes in order to receive course credit. Students who had planned to retake a Regents Exam in June or in August are also exempt from the exam requirement, provided the student successfully passed the course. Census 2020

The US Census Bureau will soon be sending reminder postcards to households who have not yet completed the 2020 Census. You can respond to the Census online, by mail, or by phone. Most responses take less than ten minutes to complete and all information is **confidential**. This means **everyone** should be counted in the Census. It is important that every individual be counted to ensure that Peekskill receives the funding needed for local programs, services and our schools. If we do not receive an accurate count, the funds will go elsewhere. If you have not already, please respond to the Census today.
