Dr. Mauricio read the following comment from dthenry:
I will attempt to keep this concise, easy to read and digest. Let me start off with 2 quotes:

- Chief Justice John Roberts who in 2017 declared: "The way to stop discrimination on the basis of race is to stop discriminating on the basis of race." In 2006, Roberts also said: "It is a sordid business, this divvying us up by race."
- Recent stats on the NYC Success Academy were published:
"All Success 8th-graders took multiple Regents, tests meant for 11th- and 12th-graders. These charter kids — mostly low-income black and Hispanic students, i.e. the children the left claims simply can't be expected to do well on standardized tests — *knocked them out of the park*.
Some 99.8% passed the algebra Regents; 47% scored a 5, the highest mark. In English, 94.6% passed; in biology, 96%.
And younger kids kicked butt too, with Success 7th graders taking the global history and geography Regents and 90% passing.
To put this in context, the pass rate for city high schoolers on the algebra test was 57% in 2022, 65% on bio, 73% on English and 74% on global history."

PSD's Code of Conduct is far too complex and should be written so that a 6th grader can read and comprehend the document. There is no reason to reinvent the wheel as there are many of examples of this on the internet.

There are also examples of student/parent (or guardian)/teacher/administrator commitments that must be signed the 1st week of school. There are 10 to 15 statements that start off with "I will". May I suggest this be implemented for the '23--'24 school year.

What will it take to return to basic learning and raising the bar. Why are children allowed to pass 3rd grade that cannot read? That makes no sense. We must do better. Parents/guardians are a key factor and should be a focus by directly involving them. It could be as simple as the student bringing home a question/topic for discussion that night.

Yes diversity is important, but the PSD has taken it to a point which now divides and segregates the students. Is that your goal? Could this be a contributing factor to bullying? If so, it is an easy fix for you to make - as we are all Americans with no label.

In closing, I would like to remind you that I have not received a response to prior Board meeting emails.
