ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

- Each week during a season, coaches are asked to submit the name of an athlete on their team who has stood out from the others.
- When the athlete is selected, their name and a complishment is put out on social media. An announcement is made in the school and their picture and a bio is placed in the bulletin board at the high school.



ELTON BRAND ACADEMY (EBA)

EBA – After School Tutorial Program

- New York State Grant Funded
- Available to all PHS students
- Mandated for all athletes with any failures
- EBA staff/coach collaboration

Started originally as CAMP INC. with the support of Elton Brand and The NYS Legislature. CAMP INC. was founded as a 501c3 in 2004.

• The Elton Brand Academy is in the final year of this five year term and the District and I are working on the five year renewal application.
