Altaris Summary

- District & Building Level Emergency Plans were reviewed and currently being updated to comply with recent NYSED requirements.
- We performed a general walk-through of each school building to identify improvement opportunities, which were discussed with the DERT at our meeting/training session.
- All necessary district-wide emergency planning steps to support prevention, response and recovery protocols and procedures were reviewed individually at each BERT class (below). We will be working with each principal over the summer to ensure everything has been completed.
- We performed the initial training of the DERT and full day sessions with each BERT in the Winter.
- We facilitated tabletop exercises in the Spring for each BERT.
- On-site drill evaluations were performed at each building and teams were debriefed.
- We have assisted in facilitating strong collaboration with community partners such as Peekskill police during drills and other emergency planning steps.
- 24/7 consulting availability was provided during the 2015-16 school year.

Altaris: Next Steps

- Summer: A general walk-through of each school building to assess progress of initiatives, identify critical hazard and collaboration with administration on improvement opportunities.
- Intermediate administrative training of the DERT (Fall 2016)
- Intermediate staff development training of each BERT (Spring/Fall day programs)
- Online training program for all general staff (typically September)
- Training program for transportation staff (typically August)
- Online Staff Development Program
 - All PCSD administrators will have access to our online staff development program that may be utilized at faculty meetings and new staff orientation.
- Evaluation and debriefing of drills at each school including:
 - Lockdowns; and
 - Evacuations.
- 24/7 consulting availability for the contracted school year.

Contracts Under \$10,000

- City of Peekskill Youth Bureau/PKMS; Provide Boatworks Project (Build a boat) services for LEAP; 2016/2017 School Year; \$5,000.00. Funding will be provided from the LEAP 21st CCLC Grant budget;
