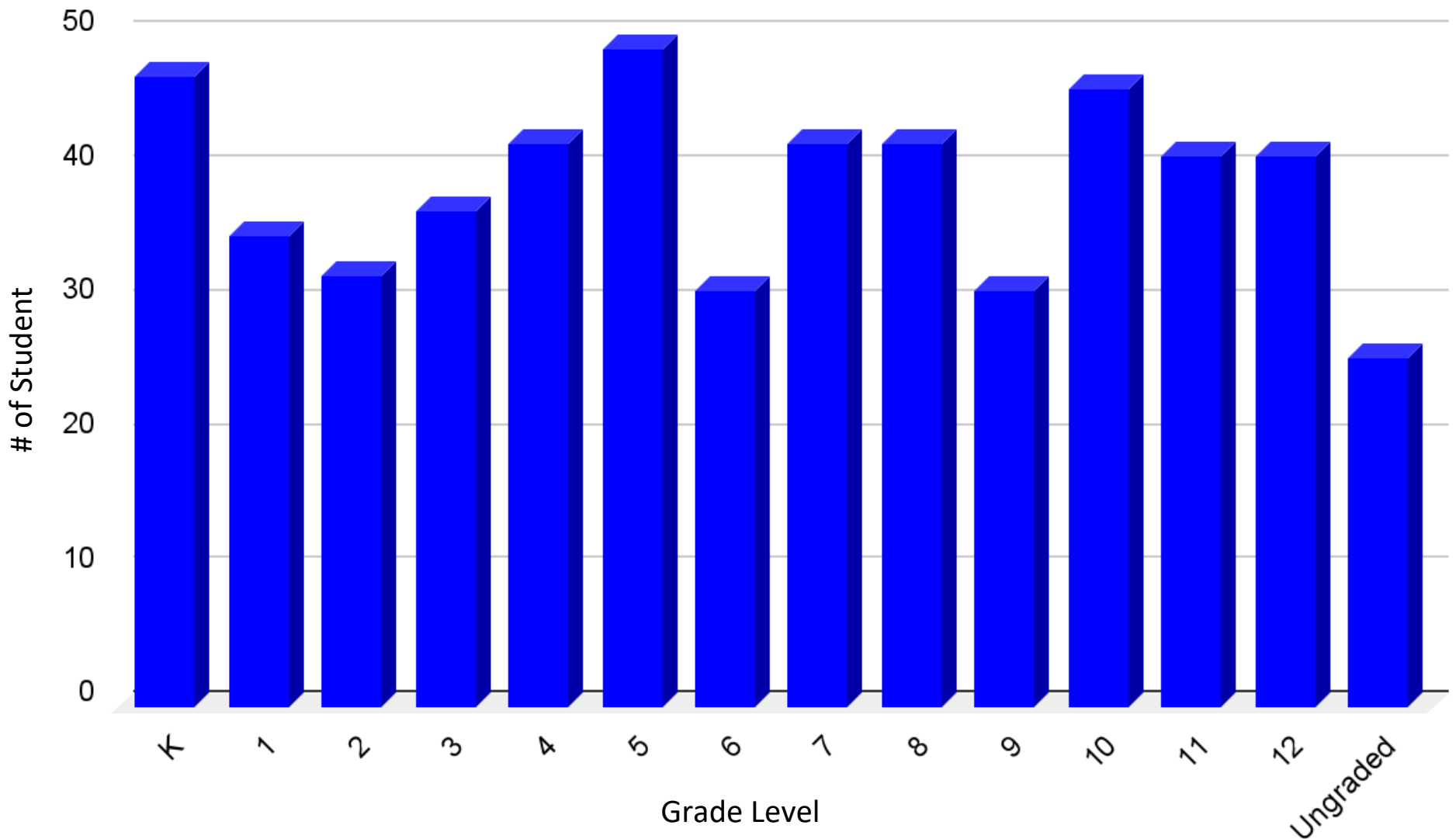

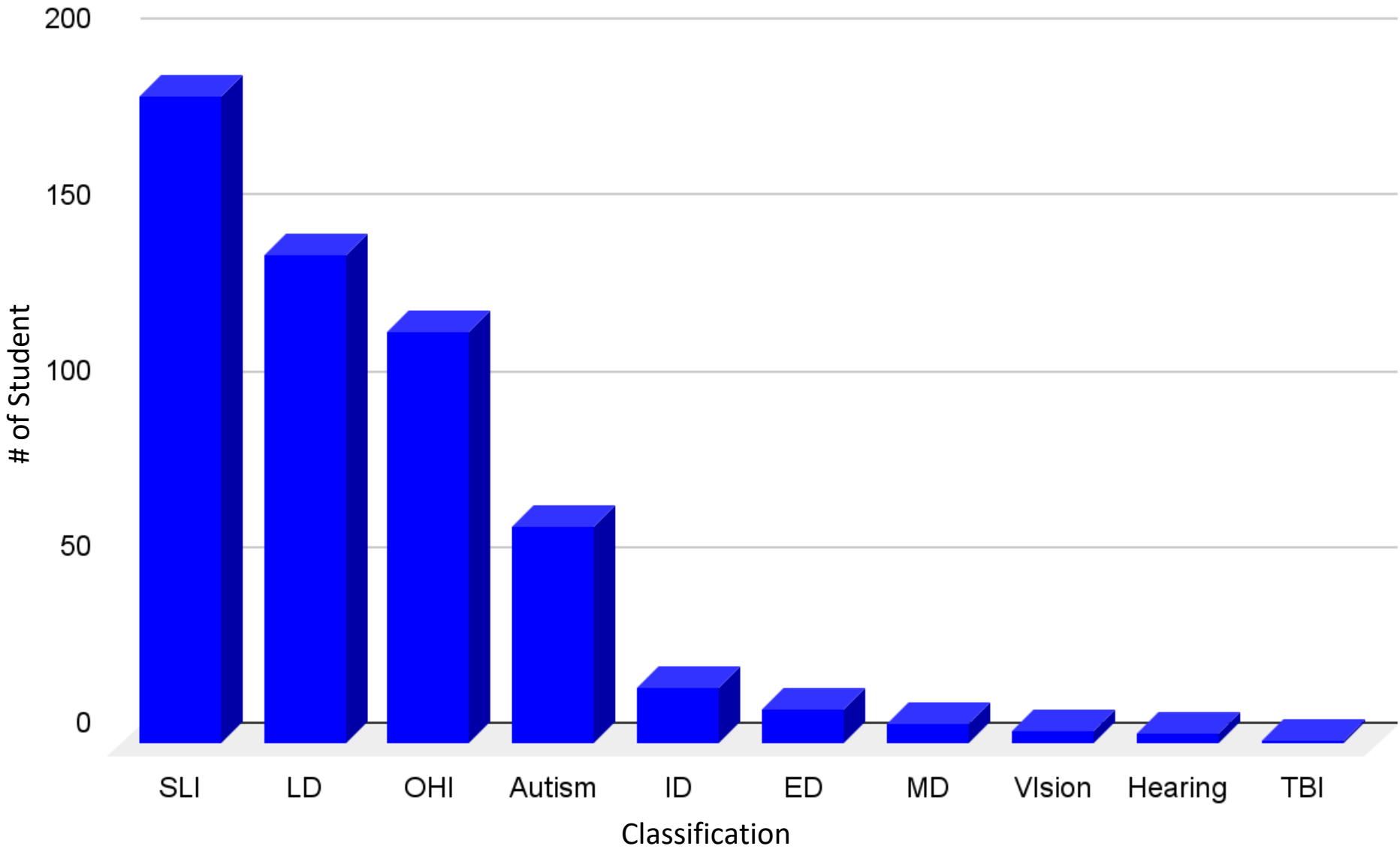

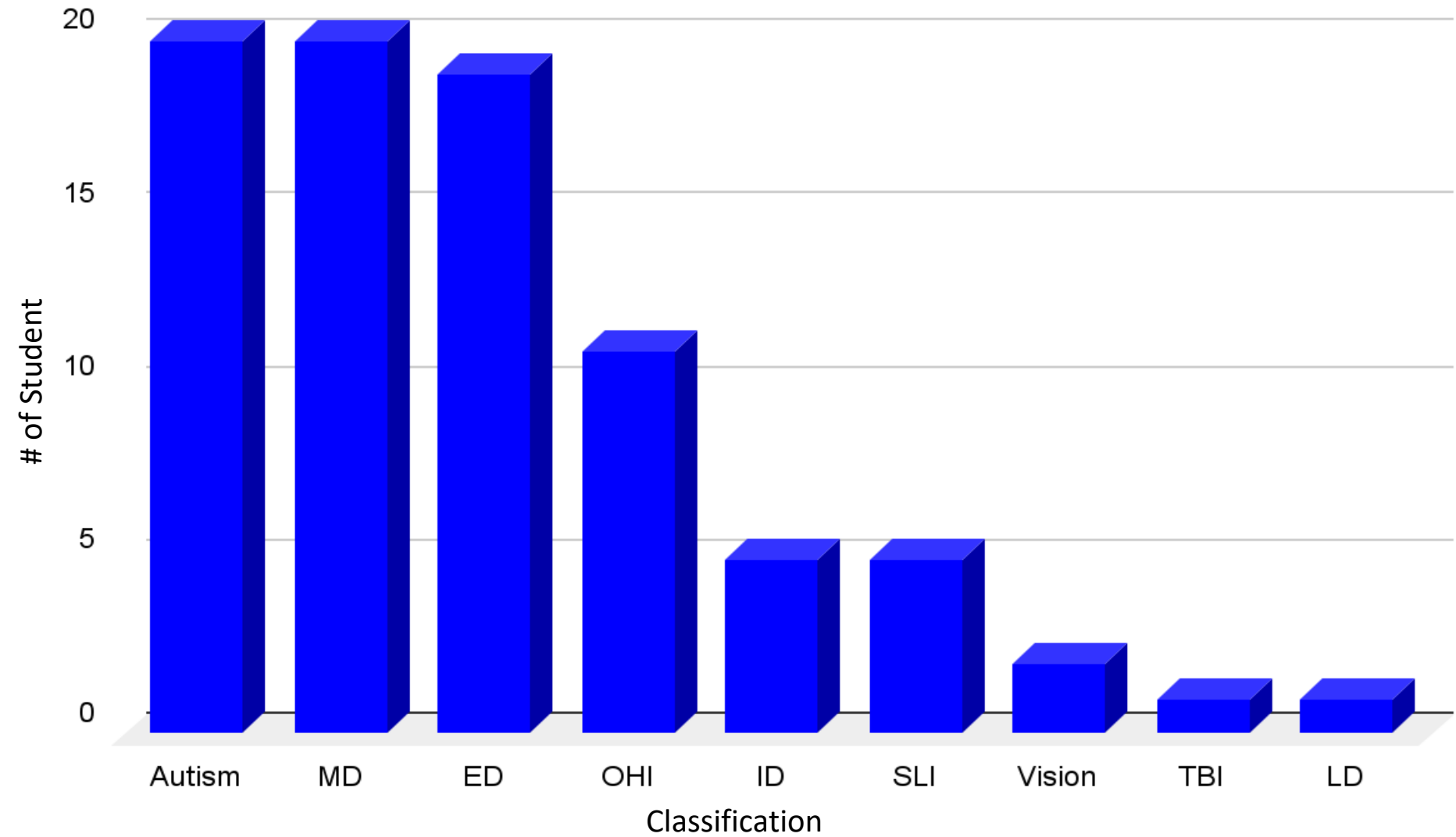

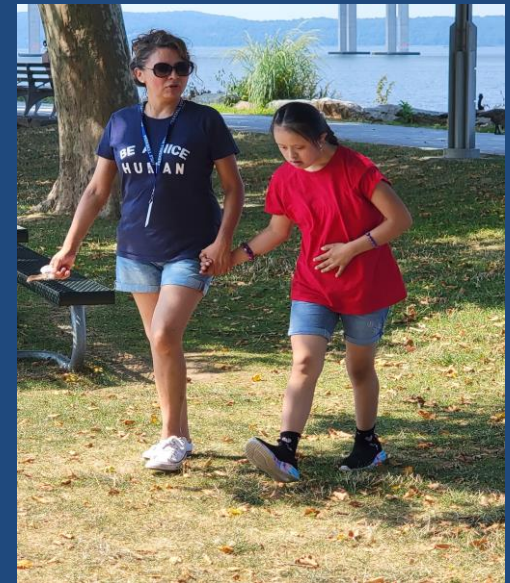


2024-2025 Budget Key Points

- Maintain clinical staff (2.0 Full Time Positions)

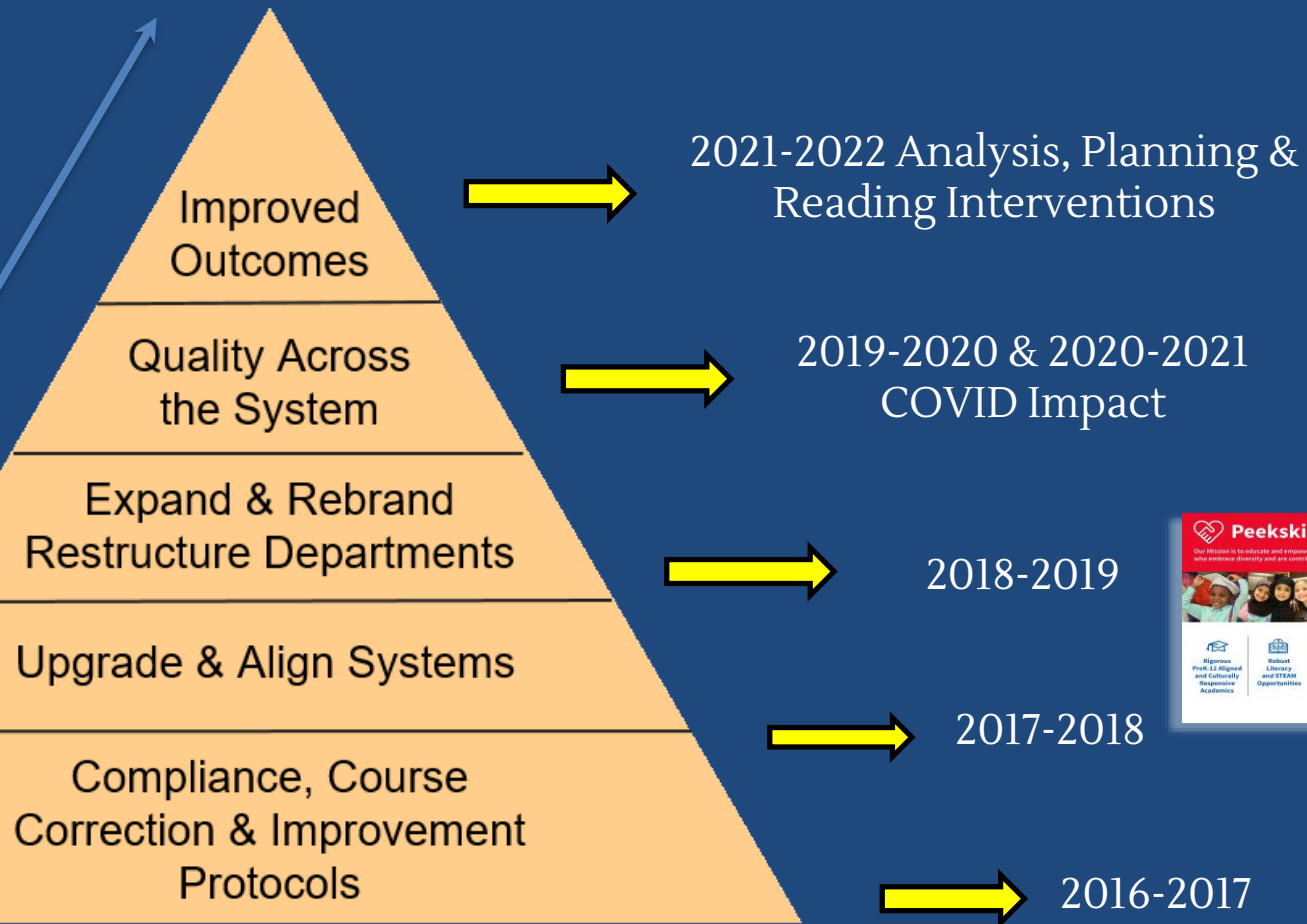

Special Education 5 Year Plan 2016-2021



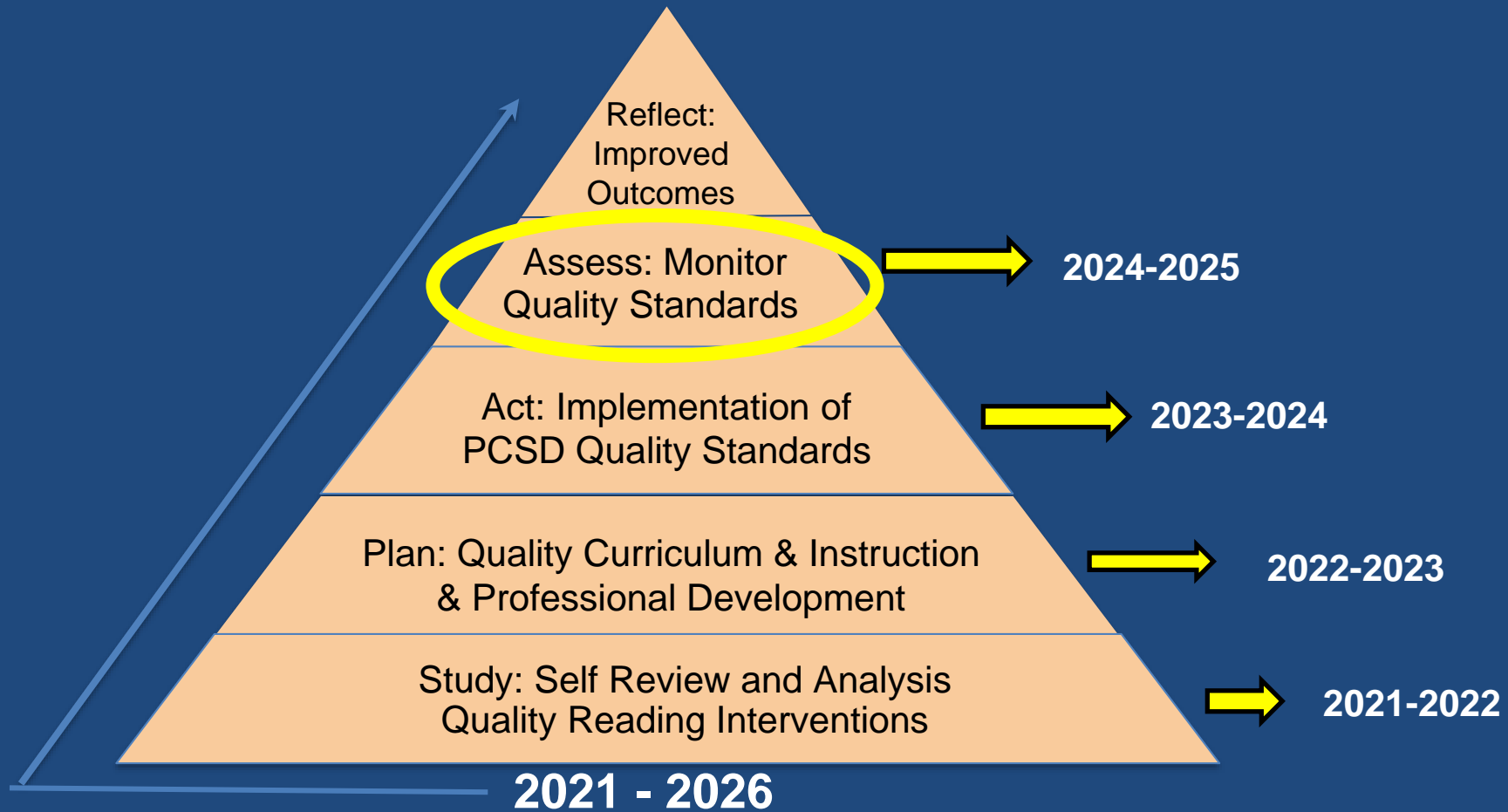
